The NU ID will be sent to the person listed in the reference via internal mail. 2. The application and attachment are submitted via internal mail. The method to receive your ID is by sending it to the person listed in the reference via internal mail. Creating data The application deadline is every Wednesday and Friday at noon. Notification is scheduled to be issued on the day following receipt of the application. (When your NU ID is issued, we will inform you.) Password Notification for the Nagoya University ID is issued. Method of reception:
